



Intermediate status of the KÖMMERLING Better World Stiftung fundraising campaign for Ukraine

Dear all,

Three weeks after the start, our humanitarian fundraiser is still running at full speed.

The fourth shipment of relief supplies has now arrived in Ukraine. The cargo from the two previous transports has already been distributed to various locations, including to those seeking protection in the shelter of the Kiev subway.

We also see a continued positive development in incoming donations: As of March 23, 2022, our so-called donation clock has grown to a total of **369,849.05 euros**.

As in the last few weeks, donations of money and goods came from a wide variety of directions.

Generous donations in various forms have come from companies such as Wasgau AG, Hornbach Baumarkt, Dienes Packaging GmbH, Fritz Krieger GmbH, Edeka Center Specht in Ludwigsfelde, Spedition Bold in Rodalben, R. Linke insect protection systems and Sophie-Charlotte-Gymnasium high school in Berlin.

A very special event was the benefit concert by the Academic Orchestra Berlin last Sunday, the proceeds of which went to our fundraising campaign.

There were also numerous private donation collections, the magnitude of which almost overwhelmed us. For example from the Merzalben volunteer fire brigade or the municipality of Woltersdorf near Berlin. In the latter alone, 24 pallets of relief supplies came together!

Against this background, we can continue to draw a positive interim balance today.

We would like to thank all donors for the steady increase! It is a great motivation for us to keep going!

Thanks to our Ukrainian colleagues, we know the situation and the needs on site and have the logistical network to enable deliveries directly to Ukraine.

We are still happy to accept monetary and material donations in order to organize further transports to Ukraine. One hundred percent of the funds go to their intended purpose, the foundation does not incur any costs because it uses the employees and the infrastructure of the company profane.

Our Ukrainian contacts have informed us that we should please refrain from donating clothes at the moment. There is already more than enough of this, and the limited transport capacities could therefore be used for other things such as food, medicine and hygiene items.
